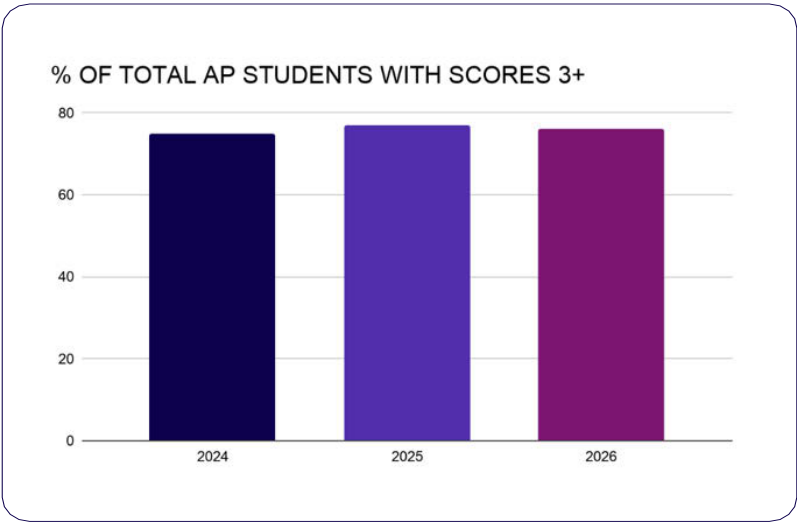


Figure 1: AP Test School Average for the last 3 years
